

## Types of Evidence/Data

### Consider:

- various types of data: student learning data, demographic data, perceptual data, school process data
- triangulating by including various ways of gathering evidence: observation, conversations and products (p. 34 *Growing Success*)
- student, teacher and leader voice as an evidence source

<p><b>Student Work</b></p> <p><b>Products:</b> e.g., exit cards, journals, blogs, tests, simulations, projects; student achievement data, surveys (classroom level)</p> <p><b>Conversations:</b> e.g., summary of key points – conferences, discussions, interviews</p> <p><b>Observation:</b> e.g., group work, projects</p>	<p><b>Teacher Work</b></p> <p><b>Products:</b> e.g., lesson/unit plans, sample tasks, assignments, assessments; professional learning cycle summary, video of classroom instruction, surveys</p> <p><b>Conversation:</b> e.g., summary of key points – peer to peer/ learning team discussion,</p> <p><b>Observation:</b> e.g., peer observation of classroom instruction</p>	<p><b>School Leader Work</b></p> <p><b>Products:</b> e.g., meeting agendas/; a description of supports for learning teams – e.g., release and planning time scheduling, facilitator, access to external experts, facilitation plans; videos, surveys principal/leader learning teams</p> <p><b>Conversation:</b> e.g., summary of key points – leader to leader/ coach/teacher discussion, learning team session</p> <p><b>Observation</b> e.g., peer observation – school visits, district reviews</p>	<p><b>Board Leader Work</b></p> <p><b>Products:</b> e.g., a description of supports for school leaders; meeting plans and materials; artefacts related to board leader learning teams; documents that align with SIP, BIPSA</p> <p><b>Conversation:</b> e.g., summary of key points – leader learning team meeting, leader to leader/mentor discussion</p> <p><b>Observation</b> e.g., peer observation – school visits, district reviews</p>
